Monitoring determined no H2S and is not an explosive atmosphere; further monitoring is being conducted to determine if there is a benzene hazard.

Areal Extent:

The entire spill was contained within secondary containment (inside the berm around the tanks).

Potential Environmental Impacts:

Impacts to surrounding environment are minimal as the entire spill was contained within secondary containment which does not allow the oil to migrate out of the secondary containment. Spill is being cleaned up immediately to further minimize any potential impacts.

Action Taken or Planned:

Once found the problem was immediately corrected by producing into a different tank. All tanks were inspected to see if the problem was found in other tanks. The manway cover was tightened and the tank was inspected to make sure that was the only problem. Air monitoring began to ensure safety and spill cleanup has begun and will continue until the entire spill is cleaned up.
