The oil sprayed on to a hayfield SE of the pad. The vegetation impacted has been mowed and removed in an area of about 150 feet wide by about 1500 feet long. Only observed a little oil staining (about 2 feet by 3 feet) on the well pad. There was still a small amount of vegetation showing oil impact, but I was informed that the landowner didn't want anything more mowed from the field. Called company contact, and he will be emailing the NDDoH the information from the landowner.
