Shutdown LACT unit to prevent oil from flowing through the system until leaking component is fixed. Dispatched clean up crew to remove the minimal area of topsoil impacted by the fluid and replace the soil. Preventive maintenance program will assist in preventing a reoccurrence of this incident.
