NDIC Field Inspector - Jim Potts was notified by telephone at 0900 on 12/05/15. The released fluids will be vacuumed up. The affected soil will be scraped up and hauled to an approved disposal facility. The surface owner was notified and will be consulted during the clean-up and remediation operations. If requested by the landowner, the removed soil will be replaced with black dirt. In the future, all cut flowlines will be immediately capped to prevent any chance of fluid release.
