There was a low potential of the release impacting surface water as the release was controlled quickly, with the dam in place and a vac truck at the release site within minutes of the incident.

A temporary earth dam was built to prevent the release from traveling to a waterway. The release was recovered via vac truck. Clean-up will continue with removal of affected soil and addition of new material (like for like).
