I called the contact on the spill report. He indicated that the sprayed vegetation was on the northeast corner of the pad. He requested the landowner come to the site and look at the area. The vegetation was mowed and bagged. I walked around the pasture and could not see any stained soil or vegetation. The area has been grazed down by the cattle.
