ICE IN FILL HOLE DID NOT PERMIT A TIGHT FIT OF DROP FITTING AND FITTING POPPED OFF DUE TO ICE AROUND FITTING. GASOLINE THEN RAN INTO THE STREET

THE SPILL KIT ON THE J5 TRUCK WAS USED TO CONTAIN SPILL. KEN STOXEN WAS CALLED AT 5:00 AM AFTER SPILL KIT WAS SET AND HE ADVISED CALLING THE BISMARCK FIRE DEPT..THE FIRE DEPT WAS IN FAVOR OF USING FLOOR DRY TO CLEANUP GASOLINE. KEN STOXEN AND MARK MILLER, DISPATCHER FOR J5 TRANSPORT,ARRIVED AT 5:45 WITH FLOOR DRY AND CLEANUP EQUIPMENT.BY 6:45 AM THE SPILL WAS CLEANED UP TO THE SATISFACTION OF MEL FISHER,ENVIROMENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRTOR FOR THE BISMARCK FIRE DEPT. USED FLOOR DRY WAS TAKEN ON A PICKUP TO MISSOURI VALLEY PETROLEUMS SHOP. THE PICKUP WAS LEFT OUTSIDE TO AIR OUT AND KEN STOXEN WILL

CALL THE HEALTH DEPT. MONDAY MORNING TO SEE ABOUT FARMING THE MATERIAL.  
PLANNED FUTURE ACTION WILL BE TO NOTIFY ALL DEALERS TO CLEAN SUMP HOLES OF  
ALL ICE TO PREVENT UNLOADING EQUIPMENT FAILURE.
