Carl Ness originally spoke to Sam Shutt (local fire chief) 3-11-13 @ 1918 (7:18pm) and had the spill under control at that time.

On 3-12-13 @ 10:30 Carl Ness called Sam Shutt as a follow up: Cenex will be disposing of the absorbents. Sam stated that the absorbent pads remove from the storm drain had very little odor. Replaced pads, but will be last set.

Storm drain impact. Absorbents deployed. Warm weather near. This should be checked to see that the storm drain is cleaned and proper precautions are taken.

On March 13, 2013 I went to Minto ND to follow up on the release from the Cenex C-Store located at 622 2nd St. I met Ms. Jennifer Tibert. She stated that the original release amount of 60 gallons was incorrect. After the incident she went through the slips and found out the person only pumped 28 gallons. So the true amount spilled was less than 28 gallons, possibly 14 to 16 gallons.

Some of the gasoline may have reached the storm sewer. Mr. Sam Shutt, City Water Works/Treatment Superintendent will be monitoring the manholes downstream from the C-Store and if anything is detected, Cenex will be notified to come and clean it up. The C-Store is located .25 miles from the Forest River.

Floor dry and pads were used by the fire department to soak up the spilled gasoline. The floor dry and pads were collected and hauled to the City of Grand Forks landfill.
