Fargo Fire Dept responded to incident. Applied floor dry to spilled gasoline and diked storm drain with floor dry. Approximately 5-10 gallons reached the storm drain. City of Fargo and Moorhead's Water Treatment Plants were notified. Fargo Street Dept notified which concluded storm drain drains into drainage ditch and releases near Harwood into Red River. No visible sheen was noticed in drainage ditch. Rainfall over weekend in Fargo flushed storm drains.
