Semitruck was traveling northbound on county road 11. The truck drove onto the shoulder and into the borrow pit. It hit an approach and landed on its side. Oil, antifreeze and diesel leaked onto the ground at the approach

## Potential Environmental Impacts:

Spill was kept from nearby reservoir. A slight chance that some residual vehicle fluids could reach the reservoir.

## Action Taken or Planned:

An earthen containment was built around the accident. The truck and trailer were hauled away. The area of the spill was excavated to a depth of 1-2 inches, the material being loaded into a roll-off dumpster and kept at the location until results of the sampling. About 20 cubic yards of contaminated soil was removed. The area will be backfilled with fresh dirt/gravel.
