North Dakota Rescue Squad  
Recertification/Continuing Education  
Training Grant Program Distribution

**Time Grant is Available:**

The grant monies are available for recertification/continuing education training occurring from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.

**Purpose:**

The grant funds will be targeted at reducing the financial barriers for Rescue Squads associated with the provision of Emergency Medical Services recertification/continuing education

**Eligibility Requirements:**

Total funds available are limited to the Division of Emergency Medical Services and Traumas' grant appropriation for this purpose. North Dakota Rescue Squads may receive up to \$500 from the Division for the purpose of conducting Emergency Medical Services (EMS) recertification/continuing education training, provided that the following conditions have been met:

- A. That the Rescue Squad's grant request is submitted on the form entitled "RESCUE SQUAD RECERTIFICATION/CONTINUING EDUCATION TRAINING GRANT REQUEST" provided by the Division of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma.
- B. That the Rescue Squad is currently certified and must have had at least 60% of its total call volume for the previous calendar year originate in North Dakota.
- C. That the Rescue Squad must have volunteers who provide patient care or rescue care who are compensated less than \$10,000 per year.
- E. That the grant requests must be received by the Division of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma on or before June 18, 2010.
- F. Each Rescue Squad will be eligible to receive only one grant per year.

Grants will be distributed in the order the completed and eligible applications are received at the Division of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma until the entire Grant fund has been disbursed.
