Be sure your child is up to date on vaccinations

As your kids head back to school this year, it's important to make sure that they are up to date on required vaccinations. The North Dakota Department of Health and a team of health-care partners will be offering immunization clinics in Williston and Watford City for school-aged children and teenagers.

No appointment is necessary. First come, first served.

All children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Please bring your child's vaccination records and insurance information to the clinic.

A nominal administration fee may be charged.

- Cash ■ Checks ■ Medicaid
- Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota

Credit cards will not be accepted.

Those with other insurance policies or Blue Cross Blue Shield from another state will need to get reimbursement from your insurer. Costs for Medicaid-eligible children will be charged to Medicaid. No one will be turned away due to an inability to pay.
