NDDoH Releases Draft Dispensary Application for Grand Forks and Williston Regions

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) released draft dispensary application materials for the Grand Forks and Williston dispensary regions. The draft application materials, including instructions, can be found on the Division of Medical Marijuana’s website at www.ndhealth.gov/MM.

“The Grand Forks and Williston regions will be the second open application period for dispensaries, with the first being in the Bismarck/Mandan and Fargo regions,” stated Jason Wahl, Director of the Division of Medical Marijuana. “It is anticipated that this second phase of dispensary applications will open by the end of September. Dispensaries selected for registration will not only dispense usable marijuana to registered qualifying patients and designated caregivers but will provide vital information and education to patients and designated caregivers,” added Wahl.

A panel will be established to review all complete applications. The panel will evaluate, score, and select applicants that will be eligible for registration through the NDDoH in the Grand Forks and Williston regions. An applicant must determine which region(s) they will be applying for. The same legal entity may apply in multiple regions but can only hold one registration certificate under the Medical Marijuana Program.

Applicants should use draft materials only to prepare for the open application period as all materials are subject to change. A \$5,000 nonrefundable application fee will be required with all applications submitted. A map of the eight regions, frequently asked questions for the dispensary map document, and frequently asked questions for compassion centers document are available on the website at www.ndhealth.gov/mm.
