

Medical Marijuana Program Implementation Status Update

The Division of Medical Marijuana, in collaboration with the North Dakota Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and the North Dakota Information Technology Department (ITD), has released the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the medical marijuana tracking system.

What is the purpose?

- In order for the Medical Marijuana Program to be implemented in an efficient and effective manner, an adequate information management system must be in place.
- The North Dakota Department of Health is required to purchase an electronic system to aid in inventory management and seed-to-sale tracking of marijuana, usable marijuana and medical marijuana waste. The system will also assist with registration of compassion centers and all cardholders, including qualifying patients, designated caregivers, and compassion center agents. In addition, the system will have the capacity to generate reports required by state law.

What is the timeline?

- RFP released-November 21, 2017
- Deadline for the receipt of proposals-December 27, 2017 (3 p.m. CST)
- Notice of Intent to Award-approximately January 26, 2018
- Contract with selected vendor executed-approximately February 28, 2018
