Facility Description

The reapplication is for a surface coal mining operation near the city of Center. Any discharge would consist of ground water and/or surface runoff encountered during mining. Discharges would be to Hagel Creek, Square Butte Creek, or Nelson Lake via unnamed drainage. Hagel Creek is an unclassified stream. The portion of Square Butte Creek, below Nelson Lake, is a Class IA stream; otherwise, it is unclassified. Nelson Lake is a Class 3 lake.

The discharges covered by this permit are subject to the surface water management conditions and the designated locations described in surface mining permits approved following public review. The discharge structures are located within the boundaries of BNI Coal's approved surface mining permits which encompass all or part of the following: T142N, R84W; T141N, R84W; T142N, R83W; and T141N, R83W.

Tentative Determinations

Proposed effluent limitations and other permit conditions have been made by the Department. They assure that State Water Quality Standards and applicable provisions of the FWPCAA will be protected.
