

WIC BENEFITS AGREEMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN INSTITUTIONS

Homeless Facility/Institution

We understand the local agency of the Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children, or WIC, will serve all homeless or other women and children who meet the program income and nutritional requirements that need to live in an institutionalized residence. WIC provides nutrition education and supplemental foods to pregnant, breastfeeding and postpartum women and to children less than five years of age.

In order for our agency to make these benefits available to residents, we agree that:

- WIC foods will be available to the WIC participant only and will not be used in preparing meals for other residents. This may include providing space for the WIC client's milk, eggs, cheese and juice.
- We will assist the participant in partaking of the education benefits of the WIC Program as well as the food benefits.
- Our facility may not benefit financially from our clients participation in the WIC Program.
- WIC staff will be allowed to visit our facility to ensure our compliance with these conditions.

We agree to notify the WIC office if we are no longer able to meet the above conditions.
