

OUT-OF-STATE TRANSFER, RISK UNKNOWN

PARTICIPANT TYPE.....	ALL
HIGH RISK.....	NO

RISK DESCRIPTION:

Person with current valid Verification of Certification (VOC) document from another state. The VOC is valid until the certification period expires and be accepted as proof of eligibility for program benefits. If the receiving local agency has waiting lists for participation, the transferring participant shall be placed on the list ahead of all other waiting applicants.

Note: This risk is assigned for any out-of state transfer. If the participant was initially certified based on a nutrition risk condition not used by the ND WIC Program, the VOC is still valid and this risk factor is assigned.

ASK ABOUT:

- Treatment plans and recommendations made by their previous WIC provider
- Primary health care provider's recommendations
- Access to ongoing health care and follow-up medical care if needed

NUTRITION COUNSELING/EDUCATION TOPICS:

- Review treatment plan and any barriers to compliance with it.
- Reinforce previous counseling about health and dietary practices.

POSSIBLE REFERRALS:

- If the VOC document identifies specific risk conditions for the previous certification, the CPA is encouraged to manually assign those risks in WICnet to promote continuity in care.
- If possible, obtain documentation from the previous WIC provider as needed to promote continuity in care. Examples include nutrition care plans, blood work results, growth measurements, growth charts, and nutrition risks.
- If the participant does not have an ongoing source of health care, refer to primary care providers in the community or the local public health department.
