

Blue-green Algae Advisories and Warnings October 4, 2016

The following list includes only those lakes where;

- 1) The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a blue-green algae bloom,
- 2) The NDDoH has conducted testing.
- 3) The lake has been posted with a blue-green algae advisory or warning.

Blue-green algae blooms vary greatly in terms of when and where they occur and there may be other lakes, reservoirs, ponds, or wetlands in the state that are also experiencing blooms besides those on this list. People should familiarize themselves with what a blue-green algae bloom looks like. If they see one, they should avoid it and report it to the NDDoH through the on-line form at www.tinyurl.com/nodakhabs.

Advisory: A blue-green algae bloom is present and microcystin levels are below the public health criteria of 10 ug/L.
