Program Components:

Private Area to Express Milk:

BSC provides a place, other than a bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion from coworkers and the public, which may be used by an employee to express breastmilk.

Breastfeeding Equipment:

BSC provides a room with an outlet and a washing station. All other equipment must be provided by the employee.

Milk Expression Scheduling:

BSC states in our Guidelines for Nursing Mothers that "The frequency of breaks needed to express milk as well as the duration of each break will likely vary." This was communicated to the campus.
