SAAM Plans – Moving from Awareness to Action

- Should focus on giving participants something to “do” actions instead of only making aware of the problem. They should understand how to prevent it.
- Shared norm setting activities

Bonnie (FNWA) – Three Affiliated Tribes does annual family egg hunt with business vouchers and prevention messaging in eggs; Spirit Lake Victim Assistance and First Nations Women’s Alliance are co-sponsoring training; FNWA is doing a newsletter

Rachelle (Beulah) – put pinwheels on lawn for SAAM; Denim day posters; distributing brochures and businesses and restaurants

Greg/Suzie (RACC) – giving Green Dot Virtual Overviews and getting good attendance from influencers from downtown
