The Goodman and Wandersman Community Key Leader Survey was developed at the University of South Carolina and measures how ready community leaders are to take action on prevention. This 48-item survey utilizes a key informant approach in which community leaders respond to questions about prevention in their community across three domains: **awareness, concern** and **action**. This interview guide was inspired by the Key Leader Survey.
