

# North Dakota Car Seat Checkup Event Locations 2010



## What is a car seat checkup?

Car seat checkups teach parents and caregivers how to correctly use their child's car seat or seat belt. At the checkups, trained and certified child passenger safety technicians work with parents to ensure that children are restrained according to their specific needs. 5 out of 6 car seats are used incorrectly in North Dakota, so car seats are checked to be sure:

- They have not been recalled.
- They meet federal safety standards.
- They are installed correctly.
- They are appropriate according to the age, weight and height of children.
- The child is secured correctly in the seat.
