Purpose of Public Notice

The Department intends to reissue the following North Dakota Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NDPDES) Discharge Permit under the authority of Section 61-28-04 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Facility Description

The reapplication is for a series of waste stabilization ponds, and one holding pond, which discharge through three outfalls. The system services the City of Enderlin and an oil seed processing plant. The facility is located in the SW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 3, Township 136N, Range 55W, and the N1/2 of the NW1/4 of Section 11, Township 136N, Range 55W. Any discharges would be to the Maple River, a Class II stream.

Tentative Determinations

Proposed effluent limitations and other permit conditions have been made by the Department. They assure that State Water Quality Standards and applicable provisions of the FWPCA will be protected.
