

## **RECYCLING FOR HEALTH CARE EQUIPMENT**

Do you have equipment at home or in your health care office that is no longer needed, but you **don't** want to **throw it away**? You can now rid your home of the equipment, help others and receive a tax deduction for your donation!!!

PROJECT H.E.R.O., the Healthcare Equipment Recycling Organization will accept equipment from individuals or agencies when the items are no longer needed and recycle them to those who would benefit from the donations.

The Fargo/ Moorhead based nonprofit networks with Hospice, Churches United, the Fargo Homeless Clinic, the Native American Program, Cass and Clay County health and social service agencies as well as multiple churches and home care agencies in the surrounding communities to find an appropriate recipient for the donations. If the items cannot be recycled locally, HERO will network with various international medical mission organizations to assist someone in need.

Project HERO accepts wheelchairs, walkers, canes, crutches, bedside commodes, shower chairs, shampoo trays, raised toilet seats, and most transfer devices or mobilization carts. We also accept hospital beds and mattresses. Call to discuss any other items not listed.

**Project HERO requires that the equipment be clean and in working order.**

Any items requiring assembly or that have a mechanical operation (examples are oxygen concentrators and lift chairs) should have some evidence of its last use and/ or maintenance, have all parts available and an operational manual is requested.
