Data Entry and Forms for Diagnostic Mammogram

Scenario 1

Women's Way client has an abnormal CBE (documented breast mass, nipple drainage).

The health-care provider (HCP) orders a diagnostic mammogram.

This is the first mammogram and maybe the only mammogram in the screening cycle (depending on the results of the mammogram):

Form used for documentation

Use the Diagnostic form to document diagnostic procedures. If the HCP indicates a diagnostic mammogram and the results on the Intake and Visit form, transfer the information to the Diagnostic form. Indicate on the Intake & Visit that information was transferred to Diagnostic form. Staple together the Intake and Visit Form and the Diagnostic Form.

Data entry for CaST

Breast Procedure

Mammogram initial – even though this is a diagnostic mammogram, it should be indicated in CaST as the initial mammogram because it is the initial mammogram in the breast cycle.

Indication for Mammogram

Symptoms, abnormal CBE or previous abnormal mammogram

Scenario 2:

Women's Way client has an abnormal CBE or initial mammogram result of BIRADS 3 or greater.

Client has a diagnostic mammogram or ultrasound with the result of BIRADS 2 or another result that indicates a need for short term follow up.

The HCP orders a six month follow-up diagnostic unilateral mammogram of the affected breast.

The diagnostic mammogram was done in 6 months and it was the only mammogram in the cycle:

Form used for documentation

Use the Diagnostic form since it is a diagnostic mammogram.
