Air Pollution Control Advisory Council Schedules Public Hearing

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Air Pollution Control Advisory Council and the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) have scheduled a public hearing to address proposed changes to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules and State Implementation Plan for the control of air pollution. The public hearing will be held Tuesday, Nov. 10, 2015, at the NDDoH offices in the Gold Seal Center located at 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, N.D. The meeting will be held at 9 a.m. in the fourth floor conference room.

The primary topics to be discussed are amendments to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules, including changes to the following:

- Prevention of Significant Deterioration Program
- New Source Performance Standards
- Title V Permit to Operate Program
- Fees
- Control of Emissions from Oil and Gas Well Production Facilities

The public may submit written comments about the proposed changes by Friday, Nov. 20, 2015. Please direct any correspondence to Tom Bachman, Division of Air Quality, North Dakota Department of Health, 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, N.D. 58501-1947.

The Air Pollution Control Advisory Council is a nine-member panel that considers and makes recommendations regarding the adoption, amendment or repeal of rules and standards pertaining to North Dakota air quality.
