Be sure that your child is up to date on vaccinations required by state

As your children head back to school, it's important to make sure that they have all of their state-required vaccinations.

The North Dakota Department of Health and a team of health-care partners will offer an immunization clinic in Watford City for school-aged children and teens.

No appointment is necessary. First come, first served.

A nominal administration fee may be charged.

We will accept:

Credit cards will not be accepted. Those with other insurance policies or Blue Cross Blue Shield from another state will need to get reimbursement from your insurer.

Costs for Medicaid-eligible children will be charged to Medicaid.

No one will be turned away due to inability to pay.

All children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Please bring your child's vaccination records and insurance information. Visit www.ndhealth.gov/immunize for information on what vaccines are required by the state and how to find your child's records.
