Purpose of Public Notice

The Department intends to reissue the following North Dakota Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NDPDES) Discharge Permit under the authority of Section 61-28-04 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Facility Description

The application is for a water treatment plant which supplies drinking water to the city of Valley City. Wastewater from the operation of the microfiltration and nanofiltration membranes discharge through diffusers placed in the Sheyenne River, a Class IA stream. The two discharge points are located at latitude 46.928721, longitude -97.992304 and latitude 46.898619, longitude -98.013024.

Tentative Determinations

Proposed effluent limitations and other permit conditions have been made by the Department. They assure that State Water Quality Standards and applicable provisions of the FWPCAA will be protected.
