NRC INFORMATION NOTICE 2002-23: UNAUTHORIZED ADMINISTRATION OF
BYPRODUCT MATERIAL FOR MEDICAL USE

Addressees:

All medical licensees.

Purpose:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is issuing this information notice (IN) to remind licensees of the importance of appropriate authorization before administration of byproduct material for medical use. It is expected that recipients will review this information for applicability to their licensed activities and consider actions, as appropriate, to avoid similar problems. However, suggestions contained in this IN are not new NRC requirements; therefore, no specific action nor written response is required.

Description of Circumstances:

Over the past year, NRC has become aware of cases involving the deliberate unauthorized administration of licensed material to humans. For example, on April 26, 2001, a nuclear medicine technologist deliberately administered an unauthorized dose of technetium-99m tagged methylene diphosphonate to a student. The student requested the administration of the licensed material for a bone scan. The technologist performed the bone scan without prior authorization from a physician.

Discussion:

The regulations of 10 CFR Part 35 provide that only an authorized user physician, or someone under the supervision of an authorized user, may administer licensed material for medical uses. In the case described above, the nuclear medicine technologist administered licensed material without the approval of an authorized user. Such action by the technologist resulted in an unnecessary radiation dose to the individual.

NRC expects licensees to ensure that their staff, including nuclear medicine technologists, and other persons supervised by physicians, fully understand and adhere to the requirements associated with the medical administration of licensed material. NRC will consider enforcement actions for both licensees and their staff when NRC requirements are knowingly violated, as in the case described above.
