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# Screening

- ▶ Individuals Tested More Than 1 per year: Utilize Additional HIV Risk Factors in MAVEN

# Jail Screening

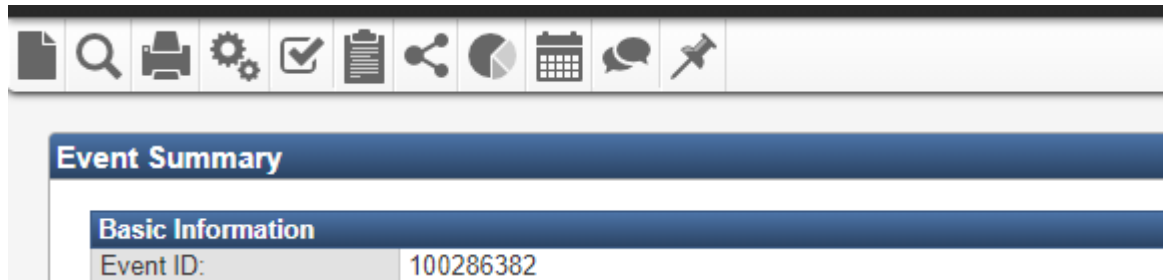
- ▶ All individuals are eligible for screening if they are incarcerated at a CTR site
- ▶ Encouraged to test more individuals than those required by law

# Testing Methods

- ▶ Rapid Testing: HIV is now Chembio
  - ▶ Control Logs: Report to Disease Control 7 Days after Performance
  - ▶ Competency Policy - Annual
- ▶ Hepatitis C Testing Methodology
  - ▶ To ensure that false positives from rapids are being recognized, the following will be the testing algorithms for hepatitis C:
    - ▶ Hepatitis C Rapid Antibody Positive – HCV RNA Quantitative Positive – No Additional Testing Needed
    - ▶ Hepatitis C Rapid Antibody Positive - HCV RNA Quantitative Negative – Confirmatory Hepatitis C Antibody
      - ▶ Call to Add on Hepatitis C Antibody or Standing Order

  - ▶ Compliance of all Rules

- ▶ MAVEN Confidentiality Policy and User Agreement
  - ▶ Signed by all users

- ▶ All CTR Sites Eligible for Hepatitis Vaccine
- ▶ Individuals must be 317 Eligible
- ▶ Ordering Once Per Month

- ▶ View Delivering HIV Rapid Test Results From the Field

## **Continuing Education – Every Two Years**

- ▶ Refresh and test competency for the use of rapid HIV & HCV testing, according to your facilities CLIA policies.
- ▶ Review CTR manual.
- ▶ 3 One Hour Presentations on HIV, Hepatitis C or STDs.

- ▶ Commonly Missed Fields:
  - ▶ Date Last Tested for HIV or Hepatitis C
  - ▶ Date Results Provided
  - ▶ Country of Birth
