Ronald McDonald Charities Care Mobile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Care Mobile is up and running, all but 3 weeks are booked through end of year • Are having good success and doing a lot of services, but not seeing as many Medicaid patients as expected. They were expecting 50-60 percent, but only 30-40 percent • They are tracking ages of the children receiving care, but currently the primary age group is elementary children

Initially was once a month, but the request and need was and still is there for more time • Restorative care has been provided to 290 individual patients, 38% of those patients needed partial or full dentures • Fillings and extractions are the most common need • They work with family of the patients to decide on the treatment plan
